## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 11

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the Texas Government Code, Section 551, as amended that the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of Harris County Emergency Services District No. 11 (the "District") will meet in regular session, open to the public, at <u>9:00 a.m., Thursday, June 24, 2021</u>, at the District's Administration Building, 18334 Stuebner Airline Road, Spring, Texas 77379, a location within the District, at which the subject of and matters to be considered and acted upon will include the following:

  - g. communications master services agreement with Comcast Enterprise Services;
  - h. professional services and bilingual language testing service agreement and statement of work with Berlitz Languages, Inc.;
  - i. interpretation and translation services contract with Voiance Language Services, LLC;
  - j. purchase request of medical safety mounts from Technimount, a sole source provider;
  - k. purchase request of emergency child restraints from BoundTree;
  - 1. purchase request of automated external defibrillator sling bags from BoundTree;
  - m. purchase request of recording system from Exacom, a Houston-Galveston Area Council Buy;

  - b. review budget comparison;
  - c. review quarterly investment report;
  - d. status of District bank accounts at BBVA and take necessary actions on same; and
  - e. amend Bookkeeping Services Agreement with Myrtle Cruz, Inc., if necessary, and take any necessary actions on same;
- 12. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report;
- 13. Communications Report, including status of public relations activities;
- 14. Attorney's Report, including:
  - a. Engage Arbitrage Compliance Specialists to perform arbitrage compliance review in connection with Series 2021 Real Estate Improvement Loan and Series 2021-A Ambulance Financing Loan;
  - b. review proposals from Election Systems & Software and Hart InterCivic for purchase of election equipment and take necessary actions on same;
  - c. review matters related to Service Agreement with CCEMS, including status of *CCEMS vs. the District, et al*, and take any necessary action on same; and
  - d. review recent Public Information Act requests, status of responses to same and *District vs. Ken Paxton*;
- 15. Review District consultant contracts, and take any necessary actions on same;
- 16. Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, (Open Meetings Act) to discuss District matters, as may be necessary; and
- 17. Adjournment.

The Board of Commissioners is authorized by the Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or Executive Session for certain purposes. These purposes include: receiving legal advice from its attorney(s) pursuant to §551.071, Texas Government Code; discussing real property matters pursuant to §551.072, Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073, Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to §551.074, Texas Government Code; and, discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076, Texas Government Code. If the Board decides to

enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.
