 - b. status of hiring for various open employment positions;
 - c. status of Medicaid approval of provider enrollment;
 - d. status of entrance into Mutual Aid Agreements;
 - e. status of First Responder Organization ("FRO") and Provider Agreement for use with overlapping FROs and take any necessary actions on same;
 - f. review and approve Off-Duty Law Enforcement Services Scheduling and Oversight Agreement with Sergeant Garrett Hardin;

 - h. status of creation of District's Standard Operating Policies and Procedures and take any necessary actions on same;

 - a. monthly operations report, financial report and prior month's data to support District's prior month's payment to CCEMS;
 - b. receive CCEMS Audit for fiscal year ended December 31, 2020;
 - c. investigation of CCEMS maintenance facility and employees related thereto; and
 - d. status of transitional matters and take any necessary actions on same;
- 10. Chief Financial Officer's Report including:
 - a. approve payment of bills and issuance of checks;
 - b. review draft budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022;
 - c. review investment report;

- d. review options for transfer of District bank accounts and accept same;
- e. approve and authorize execution of Depository Pledge Agreement with applicable depository bank; and
- f. review and amend District Investment Policy, if necessary;
- 11. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report;
- 12. Discuss proposed 2021 tax rate, hear Financial Advisor's recommendation, set public hearing date and authorize publication of applicable Notice of Public Hearing regarding same;
- 13. Communications Report, including status of public relations activities;
- 14. Discuss and take necessary action in connection with obtaining insurance proposal (expires October 13, 2021);
- 15. Attorney's Report, including:
 - a. review update from 87th Legislature;
 - b. adopt Order Declaring Property as Surplus or Salvage and Authorizing Sale or Disposal of Same;
 - c. review matters related to Service Agreement with CCEMS, including status of *CCEMS vs. the District, et al*, and take any necessary action on same; and
 - d. review recent Public Information Act requests, status of responses to same and *District vs. Ken Paxton*;
- 16. Review District consultant contracts, and take any necessary actions on same;
- 17. Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, (Open Meetings Act) to discuss District matters, as may be necessary; and
- 18. Adjournment.

The Board of Commissioners is authorized by the Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or Executive Session for certain purposes. These purposes include: receiving legal advice from its attorney(s) pursuant to §551.071, Texas Government Code; discussing real property matters pursuant to §551.072, Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073, Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to §551.074, Texas Government Code; and, discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076, Texas Government Code. If the Board decides to enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.
