  - a. review compliance, communications, clinical matters and operations;
  - b. status of Accredited Center of Excellence accreditation application submission;
  - c. review proposal from Cummins, Inc. for generator maintenance and take any necessary actions on same;
  - d. review and approve Burnet EMS Training Center Training Site Agreement;
  - e. review and approve ACETECH Corp, Inc. Subscriber Agreement and Service Agreement;
  - f. dispatch and billing software licensing updates and take any necessary actions on same; and
  - g. review and approve Affiliation Agreement with Rice University Emergency Medical Services;

- d. status of *Cypress Creek Emergency Medical Services vs. the District, et al*, and related legal matters and take any necessary actions on same;
- 10. Review District personnel matters, including review and amend District Organizational Chart, as necessary;
- 11. Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, ("Open Meetings Act") to discuss District matters, as may be necessary; and

If the Board decides to enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the OMA that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.
